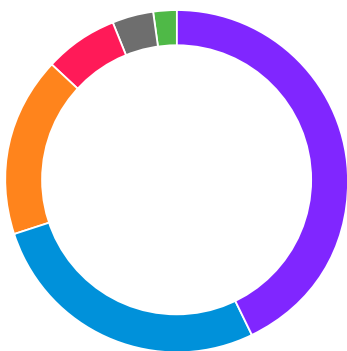

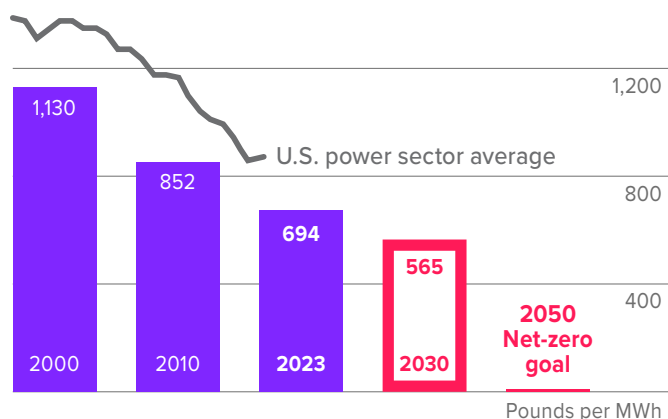
Natural gas utilities and infrastructure

Progress toward our 2050 net-zero commitment

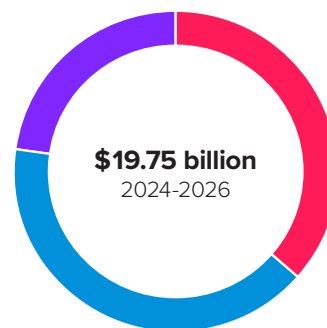

U.S. average presented through 2022

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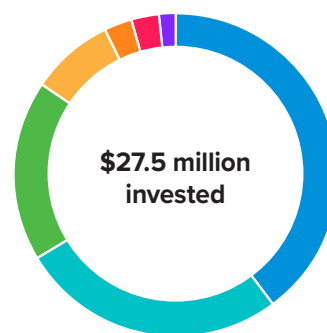
Three-year capital plan
