## **Proper COVID-19 Vaccine Storage and Handling to Minimize Wastage**

Although COVID-19 vaccine wastage is low in Louisiana, every dose counts! Proper storage and handling of all COVID-19 vaccines is essential to protecting the supply and making sure that more people can be vaccinated. Please use the below chart to safely store and monitor COVID-19 vaccines to ensure effectiveness.

A large portion of COVID-19 vaccine wasted in Louisiana has involved vaccine expiring due to scheduled recipients not being administered the vaccine for one reason or another (e.g., illness, cancellations, refusals) and facilities not being able to find other recipients while the vaccine is still viable. To avoid further waste, we strongly encourage you to have a list of alternate/backup recipients who may be given the vaccine in case recipients who were originally scheduled are not available.
