When initiated into the Entered Apprentice degree, I was induced to swear that, "I will always hele, ever conceal and never reveal any of the secret arts, parts or points of the hidden mysteries of ancient Freemasonry, which have heretofore, may at this time or shall of any future period be communicated to me as such."
